ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ **IMAGE MUST BE ORIGINAL, CONNECT THE BLACK SKIMMER TO ITS LOCAL HABITAT, AND SIGNED ON FRONT WITH ARTIST'S FIRST NAME ONLY**
- ✓ **ART MEDIUMS:** Ink, Watercolor, Acrylic, Pencil, Pastel, Charcoal or 2D Collage (3D will not be accepted)
- ✓ **SIZE:** 8 x 11 inches mounted on 9 x 12 inch construction paper (Artist's choice of color)
- ✓ **ENTRY FORM:** Must be downloaded, copied, completed and mounted on back of construction paper
