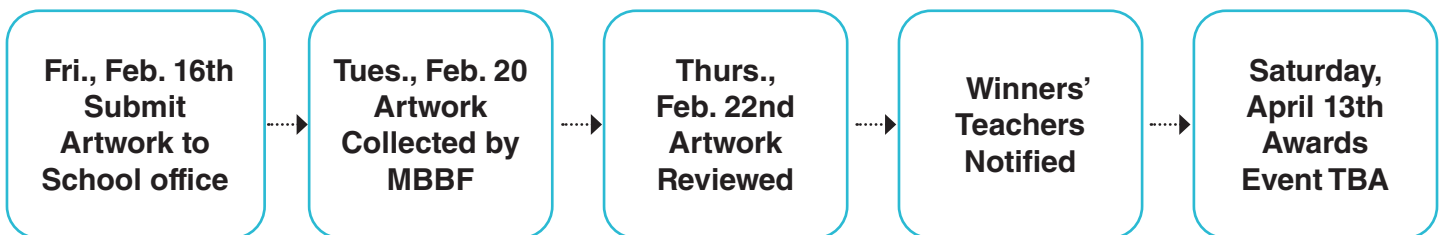

- Entry (1 per student) will be turned into the school's front office or Contest Coordinator by Friday, February 16th by 3:30 p.m. (To be collected by a MBBF affiliate on Tuesday, February 20th beginning at 8:00 a.m.)
- Winners' monetary award will be shared equally between artist and teacher.
- Grades K through 3: First place \$200, Second place \$100, Third place \$50
- Grades 4 through 8: First place \$200, Second place \$100, Third place \$50
- Grades 9 through 12: First place \$200, Second place \$100, Third place \$50
- Prizes will be awarded to "Honorable Mentions".
- **Winning Entries** and Honorable Mentions will be displayed with the student's first name and school name during the 2024 Matagorda Bay BirdFest.
- The Awards Event will be held on Saturday, April 13th. The time and place in Palacios TBA.
- Winning entries (1st, 2nd, 3rd places) will be property of the Matagorda Bay Birdfest for one year. Photographs of winning work **may be** copied by MBBF, posted on MBBF website, other social media and appropriate publications. Student's name, school and grade will be released along with photo of winning art entry.
- Non-placed entries will be returned during the 2024 Spring Semester to their corresponding schools.
